NURSING ENTRANCE EXAM

The **Next Generation Accuplacer** is the required entrance exam for all Nursing applicants, regardless of previous collegiate courses/degrees.

Exam must be taken within one (1) year of the desired program start date.

What is on the exam?

The test has three sections:

Reading: 20 multiple-choice questions

Writing: 20 multiple-choice grammar questions

Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics (QAS): 20 multiple choice questions

The test also has a WritePlacer portion. However, Nursing prefers Writing.

How much does the test cost?

The full test is \$15

What is the retest policy?

For Nursing purposes, you are allowed to take the Accuplacer two times within a 6-month period. It is recommended you wait at least two weeks in order to allow for study or remediation. The higher of the two scores will be accepted.

You may retake the entire exam or any section of the exam.

Do I need to send my scores to the Nursing Department?

If you test at ASU-Beebe, you do not need to send your scores to Nursing.

If you test at any other testing location, you will need to share your scores with ASU-Beebe through the Accuplacer Score Report.
